

Press Release for Superintendent Search

The Tallassee City Schools Board has started its search for a new Superintendent of Schools. The Board is an elected body and by state law is charged with the responsibility of hiring the superintendent. The decision as to who is appointed superintendent rests squarely with the Board. This is an important responsibility since by state law the superintendent serves as the Chief Executive Officer of the school system. In that capacity the superintendent sees that the laws relating to the schools and the rules and regulations of the Board are carried out. The qualifications for the position are prescribed by state law and the Board. Closing date for applications to be received is Monday, August 24, 2020.
