## State BOE Approves FY21 Budget Request, Discusses Teacher Shortage Task Force Recommendations

This week's State Board of Education meeting featured a lengthy list of resolutions honoring Alabama educators and proclaiming a host of education-related observances for the month of October. The board unanimously approved the ALSDE's FY21 budget request, which includes an increase of more than \$300 million over the FY20 budget.

The board work session following Thursday's meeting featured updates from ALSDE staff on the Alabama Teacher Shortage Task Force, the Computer Science Education Task Force, the Division of Instruction, the state's strategic plan for education, proposed endorsement requirements for the new dyslexia therapist certification and the proposed math course of study.
