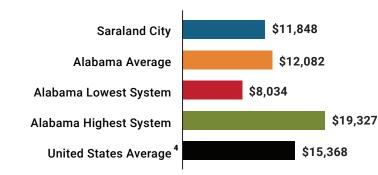

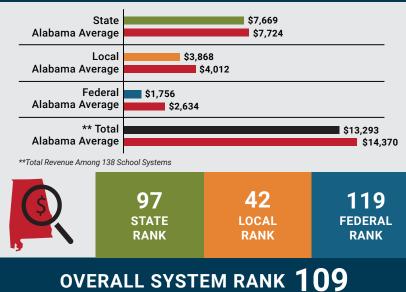

Per-Pupil Revenue Sources

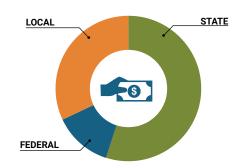
Saraland City Revenue Sources
