SBOE Discusses Potential Math Legislation, ELA Textbook Selection Process

State Superintendent of Education Dr. Eric Mackey spoke during Thursday's board work session about the ALSDE's strategy for increasing math achievement. He told the board Sen. Arthur Orr currently is working on a "math bill" to be introduced this legislative session, but a final draft is not yet available. Board members stressed the importance of being included in any discussions related to the bill and having the opportunity to provide input on any education-related legislation being crafted.

Other work session discussion the ELA textbook selection process, with board members calling for increasing transparency for parents.

The work session included lengthy discussion about several legislative matters and upcoming bills such as a first grade readiness bill and an Alabama Course of Study Law that would pay committee members more than per diem to cover costs for travel to Montgomery which is required for multiple meetings.

The brief meeting preceding the work session included passage of resolutions related to Career and Technical Education, including adoption of the State Course of Study for Architecture and Construction, Information Technology, and Transportation, Distribution and Logistics, as well as approval of textbooks for Business Management and Administration, Finance, Marketing, Manufacturing, and Work-Based Learning.
