## **Governor Ivey Issues Mask Mandate for Schools**

On Wednesday, July 29, Governor Kay Ivey took important actions that will impact our schools as we reopen. The order:

- Extended the Safer at Home order;
- Extended the Statewide Mask Mandate; and
- Extended the Mask Mandate to school employees and students in grades two and up.

Today's order is attached for reference, but in summary, the order applies to all school employees and students beginning in second grade, when they are within six feet of another person. (Order pp.8-9). The order applies to public and private schools as well as colleges and universities and expires August 31, 2020.

If your schools are reopening to in-person instruction, you may need to update your safety plans to reflect this requirement.
